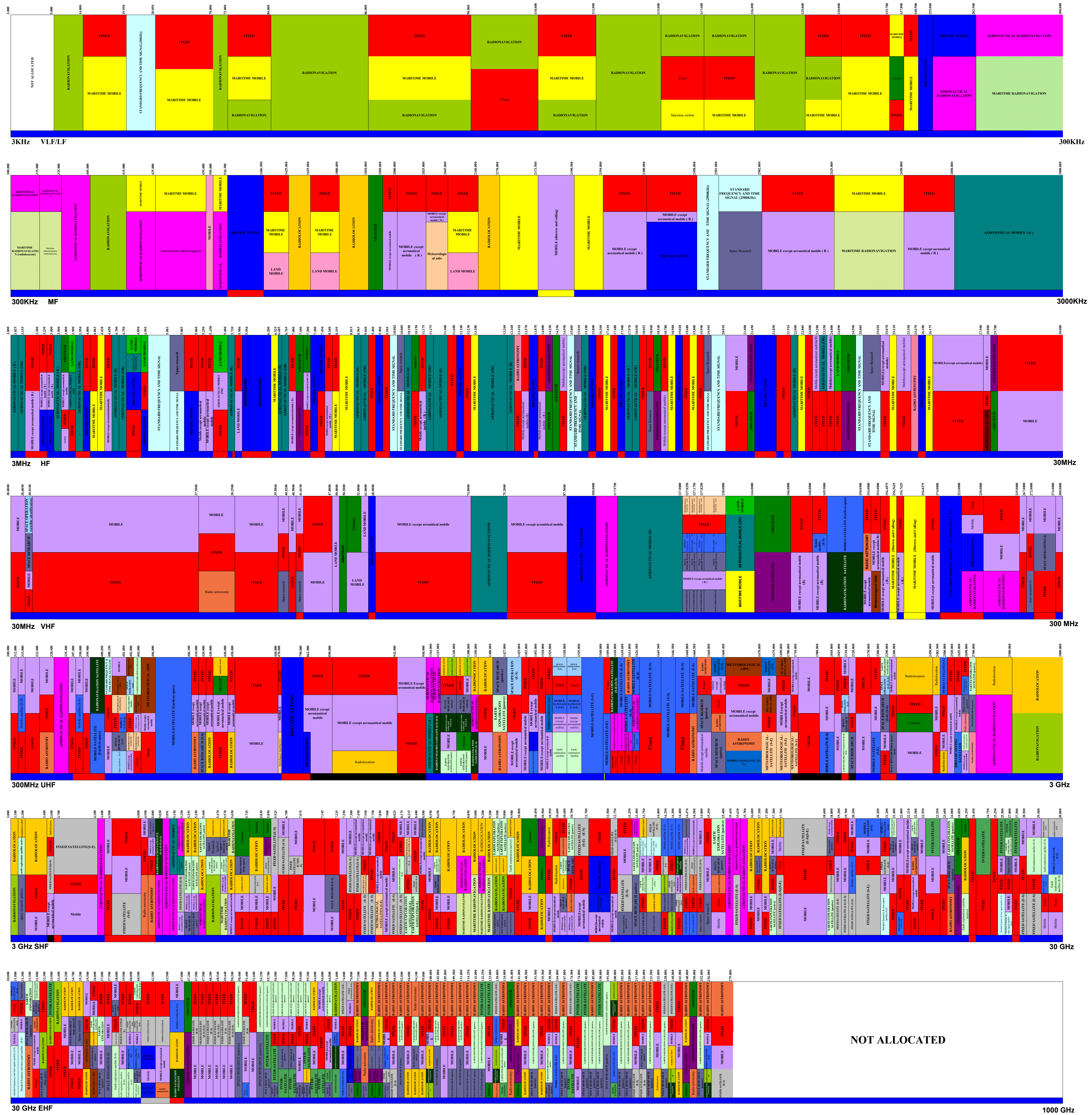


# KINGDOM OF BAHRAIN NATIONAL FREQUENCY CHART
