

PUBLIC NOTICE No. 1

concerning

Award of Individual Mobile Telecommunications Licences and associated Frequency Licences for the delivery of mobile telecommunications services in the 900, 1800, 2100 and 2600 MHz bands in the Kingdom of Bahrain – Invitation to Tender

The Telecommunication Regulatory Authority (the “Authority”) hereby provides notice to members of the public, including those interested in participating in the referenced tender process, of a change in the Auction Timetable as set out in the Invitation to Tender (“ITT”) that was issued by the Authority on 28 January 2013.

Following the receipt of queries from Registrants regarding the ITT, the Authority has, in accordance with Section 5.1 of the ITT, decided to amend the Auction Timetable set out in Table 2 of the ITT as follows:

- The Authority expects to provide Registrants with answers to all questions that have been submitted in relation to the ITT by no later than **13 March 2013**;
- The deadline for Registration by interested parties, including payment of the Registration Fee, is hereby extended to **18 March 2013 at 4:00 pm** Bahraini time;
- Registrants shall submit, to the Authority:
 - the Pre-Qualification Documentation and information set out in Annex 2.2 of the ITT (to be included in Envelope A); and
 - the documentation set out in Annex 2.3 of the ITT (to be included in Envelope B)

on **19 March 2013, no later than 4:00 pm** Bahraini time.

Any reference in the ITT to the specific dates referred to above, or any other reference to dates or actions that are contingent upon or associated with these dates, should be interpreted as having also been amended in a manner that reflects the changes to the Auction Timetable set out above.

The Authority intends to publish on 13 March 2013 any amendments to the ITT that it deems necessary and appropriate in line with its responses to the queries that have been submitted by Registrants concerning the ITT. The Authority may also issue additional modifications to the Auction Timetable if it deems it necessary and appropriate to do so prior to commencing the Auction Phase.
